INSTRUCTIONS

Necessary documentation:

- **Applicants bound for Havana on TDY travel must provide both country clearance cables** (outgoing and incoming)
- A completed Cuban visa application form
- Valid and signed passport (with a validity of at least 6 months prior to the date of travel)
- 2 photos between 1 ½ by 1 ½ and 2 by 2 inches (37-50 mm) square

The Cuban visa application form must be typed, and photos should be stapled to the top right-hand corner of the form. Note that some fields have already been filled in for your convenience. Please do not alter them. *It is required by the Cuban government to mark N/A in any boxes where information is not applicable.*

NOTE: The Cuban visa application form format and margins **may not** be changed. You must fit your responses in the given spaces only.

The Cuban Interests Section in Washington requires on average a minimum of 21 business days to process applications.
